This phase of the investigation was thoroughly looked into and the Warren Commission concluded there was no association between Ruby and Oswald whatsoever. This appears to be but one of the many complaints we have been receiving since District Attorney Garrison in New Orleans has been conducting his investigation. No action is warranted.
