The plot is supported to have hit a clinker when Oswald was captured in a Dallas theater which was to have been his hideout until dark that Nov. 22.

However, in early 1964, Misphi Cuban leaders were shown the mystery man's photos and asked to help uncover his hiding place, at that time believed to be somewhere in Miami or Tam-

Long before the Warren Commission report appeared, Vecret Service and FBI agenty discounted the stopy.

Gartison quietly re-off-ned the conspiracy phase of the asransination last October. He said he was prompted by "valid reports" that a plot to kill the President was hatched in New Orkans during the summer of 1963.

New Orleans' Cuban colony, far less organized and with less leadership than Miand's, has pulled into a shell since Garrison's new drive has riddled the area with public and private prestigators.

The PBI and Secret Servion reports on the investigation of this man are available to Garrison, but he has not asked for them.

Nor has he changed his mind about turning over any of his is of rmation to the federal agencies.


They in turn are giving the district attorney's probe the cold shoulder and have asked for none of his findings. Even Garrison's own bomielde bureau is being kept in the dark.



He was returned to New Orleans the weeks ago and placed in Parish Prison, an antiquated and decrepit county jail here, to be available for Garrison's questioning.
