Op I have previously furnished you information received concerning the investigation being conducted by New Orleans District Attorney James C. Garrison concerning the assassination of the late Fresident John Titzgerald Kannedy. In the memorandum on this matter dated march 3; 1957, which was enclosed with my letter to you of the same date, mention was made of a Martin Layton (phonetic) who, allegedly, was the "trigger man" in a plot to assassinate President Kennedy. Although our files contain no information identifi able with this individual, Special Agents of this Bureau interviewed a Layton Patrick Fartens in the course of the angassination investigation and our files do contain some information about him. Eccause of the similarity of names, especially when "Martin Layton" is reversed, there is attached a memorandum which sets forth information on Layton Patrick I thought this information would be of interest to the President.
