In connection with your inquiry concerning Countssion Document Number 75, your attention is directed to our. letter of August 10, 1965, entitled "Public Disclosure of Farron Coumission Records." Attached to our letter of Accust 10, 1965, was a monorandum dated August 10, 1965, which set forth the results of our review of enterial available at the Matieral Archives in connection with the Farren Commission Beport. Page eleven of this list set forth the exact pages of Conmission Document Bunber 75 which were to be excluded from the public donain. Also set forth were the guidelines which were applicable to the pages which were to be excluded from public review.

Our basic position concerning the public disclosure of material engrating from this Bureau in connection with .. our investigations of events relating to the assassination of President John F. Konnedy was expressed in our letter to you of February 15, 1965, and was repeated in our letter of August 10, 1965. You were informed that it was our view that the final decision as to the public disclosure of the material in question rests with the Department of Justice.

In accordance with your request, we will disseminate to you on an impediate basis as we have been doing data relating to the investigation of the assassination now being conducted by Few Orleans District Attorney James C. Garrison.
