ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY NOVEMBER 22, 1963 DALLAS, TEXAS

Stewart Medwin, Collier Encyclopedia, 322 Railway Express Building, 909-17th Street, Denver, Colorado, stated that Julian Buznedo, a Cuban refugee, is employed as a salesman by him.

Julian Buznedo, 1107 South Lincoln, Denver, Colorado, stated that he at one time knew David Ferrie of New Orleans, Louisiana. He stated that a Julian or Julius Buznedo (different spelling) was mentioned in the March 17, 1967, Denver Post, as being present at one of the alleged meetings, where President John Fitzgerald Kennedy's assassination was planned. Julian Buznedo stated that on the dates of the alleged meetings he was not in New Orleans, Louisiana, and knows nothing of any plans to assassinate President Kennedy.
