Andrews is the individual who testified before the Warren Commission concerning the mysterious Clay Bertrand who supposedly telephoned him at a time he was under heavy sedation and asked him to represent Lee Harvey Oswald, following the Kennedy assassination. He eventually testified that this call must have been an hallucination. He previously told us that he once attended a meeting of anti-Castro Cubans at David W. Ferrie's residence at which time there was a discussion of breaking into a military base magazine bunker for the purpose of stealing weapons, grenades, etc. He said that neither Oswald nor Clay Shaw were at this meeting. A subsequent teletype from New-Orleans advised that Clay L. Shaw has been indicted by the Orleans Parish Grand Jury for conspiring with William David Ferrie, Lee Harvey Oswald and others to assassinate President Kennedy.
