There are enclosed herewith two Xerox copies of a letter received from Fred H. Vincon, Jr., Assistant Attorney General, Criminal Division, of the Department dated 3/23/67. Also enclosed are two Xerox copies of letter of 3/23/67 to the Attorney General from Dante B. Fascell, a member of the United States House of Representatives, which enclosed to the Department a copy of a letter dated 3/5/67 received by the representative from [redacted]

As you will note, [redacted] claims knowledge of a multiplicity of matters, all of which are of considerable public interest and have been explored extensively in the newspapers and other news media.

A review of Bureau files shows that [redacted] is quite likely unreliable and possibly emotionally unstable and from information available at the Bureau it does not appear that any useful purpose would be served by interviewing him. If you agree with this conclusion, there is no need to interview him at this time.

In order that the Department will be aware of [redacted] background, who is a chronic complainant, you should prepare an appropriate letterhead memorandum suitable for dissemination to the Department on [redacted]. The letterhead memorandum should reach the Bureau within ten days of the date of this communication.
