This source further advised that he had been approached by SALVATORD PANZECA and BOL WILSON regarding testifying to the above information on behalf of CLAY SHAW.

PANZECA is a member of the firm representing SHAW. It is to be noted that BOB WILSON is probably ROBERT A WILSON former Special Agent of the FBI.

This source further advised that in approximately January, 1967, LYNX LOISEL, a member of GARRISON's staff, drove him down Dauphine St. in New Orleans, and pointed out a white house with a red door, LOISEL asked the source if he could get into the house and put something in it and get out without being detected. The source declined to do this. He was told by LOISEL that this had something to do with the KENNEDY assassination and that the residence pointed out was that of CLAY SHAW. The source said he was not told what he was to do in the house or what he was to place in the house,

The source claimed he was given the District Attorney's office confidential telephone number 822-2184, however, this was later changed and he was given the present number of 822-0584, which he was to use in contacting the DA's office.

further/advised that he is quite upset over the fact that JOSEPH MARAULT, JR., who is Director of International Relations Office for the City of New Orleans issued public statements while attending an oil company congress held in Mexico City during the first of April, 1967, to the effect that Washington was obstructing GARRISON's investigation, which statements were played up prominently in the newspaper "FL Universal", Mexico City on 4/4/67.

Said that because of RAULT's "quasi" official status as Director of the International Relations Office for the City of New Orleans, he felt RAULT should not be making statements of this nature.
