ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT
JOHN F. KENNEDY, Dallas, Texas 11/22/63

On 4/12/67, C. M. DeWITT, Investigation Section, U.S. INS Office, Miami, advised that 1 or 2 weeks ago a Mr. HIETZMAN (Phonetic) of INS, New Orleans, telephoned for information concerning SYLVIA ODIO, a Cuban exile who had been living in Dallas at time of assassination, and who now resides in Miami. PK Fla TEXAS Cuba

As the Bureau is aware, SYLVIA ODIO was interviewed by Bureau Agents, by counsel for the Warren Commission concerning her claim of a visit to her Dallas apartment in the last week of September, 1963, by two Cubans or Mexicans and an American whom she believed to be LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

Mr. DeWITT said he did not know the basis for interest by INS, New Orleans, in ODIO but believed it was based on an article which appeared under the byline of ROBERT ALLEN and PAUL SCOTT in the 3/1/67 issue of the NORTHERN VIRGINIA SUN (place of publication not known) which was sent to INS, Miami by the Central Office of INS, Washington, D.C. This article was entitled "OSWALD LINKED TO CUBAN WOMAN," the woman identified in the article as Mrs. SYLVIA ODIO.

Subsequently on 4/12/67, Mr. DeWITT advised he had just called INS, New Orleans, and ascertained that the
