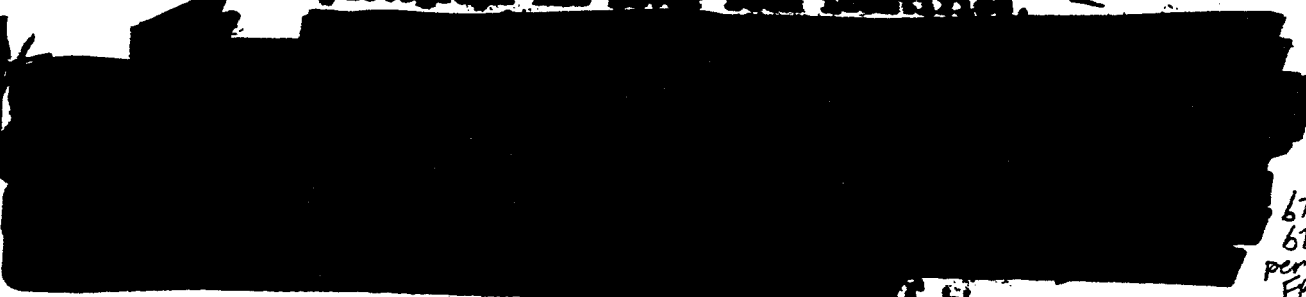

If a photograph of [redacted] exists, Bureau will compare with the man depicted in Commission Exhibit 287. This man was actually photographed while entering, as well as while departing, the Soviet Embassy, Mexico City, Mexico, and Bureau possesses several photographs made by CIA of him. If [redacted] information is correct and the man turns out to be [redacted], further investigation of him is obviously warranted to determine why he visited the Soviet Embassy, Mexico City, in October, 1963. *Qu*
