Garrison's letter contained a photostat of the handwritten draft referred to in it, as well as a typewritten transcript of this draft. The transcript read as fellows:

"Transcript of written draft of letter found in apartment of Gordon Novel after his departure from the city.

"Dear Hr. Weine:

"This letter is to infers you that District (sic) Jin Carrison has subpossed syself and an associate to testify before his Grand Jury on matters which may be classified Top Secret.
