ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY,

INFO CONCERNING, OO DALLAS.

WDSU RADIO NEWSCAST, TWO THIRTY PM, INSTANT DATE,  
REPORTED THAT WILLIAM H. GURVICH, FORMER CHIEF AIDE FOR  
DISTRICT ATTORNEY JIM GARRISON IN THE INVESTIGATION OF THE  
ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY HAS BEEN SUBPOENAED BY  
THE ORLEANS PARISH GRAND JURY FOR WEDNESDAY, JUNE TWENTY  
EIGHT NEXT. IN ADDITION LEONARD GURVICH AND LOUIS GURVICH,  
BROTHERS OF WILLIAM GURVICH, HAVE ALSO BEEN SUBPOENAED.  
ADDITIONALLY, AARON KOHN, E. E. UPTON AND WILLIAM MONAGHAN  
OF THE METROPOLITAN CRIME COMMISSION, AND ED PLANER, NEWS  
DIRECTOR OF WDSU-TV, HAVE ALSO BEEN SUBPOENAED TO APPEAR  
BEFORE ORLEANS PARISH GRAND JURY.
