ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT
JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY

Reurtel 6/23/67 and reurairtel 6/23/67 with attached LHM, both setting forth information furnished to your office by Layton Patrick Martens alleging possible wire tapping of his father's residence. Your particular attention is called to page two of your LHM. In the first full paragraph of page two you indicate that your source advised that information had been received that the telephone company employee allegedly involved, etc. It is not completely clear to the Bureau who this telephone company employee is. In the event it is John D. Olsen, you should use Olsen's name instead of referring to him as the telephone company employee allegedly involved. You should immediately submit an amended page two of your LHM dated 6/23/67 clarifying this matter.

You also report that your source advised that District Attorney James C. Garrison's office had determined there is an unlisted, nonpublished telephone number in New Orleans listed to the name of Bertrand. You should advise whether your office has a completely reliable source who would be in a position to furnish information in this matter and, if so, you should submit your recommendations as to whether he should be contacted to determine the identity of such Bertrand.
