The St. Louis Division has extensive information relative to DOH LOHBECK [redacted] While LOHBECK resided in Santa Fe and Albuquerque, New Mexico, he was an extremely controversial figure in various fields and [redacted]

His activities came to the attention of the Albuquerque Division frequently during this period; however, no current contacts or information have been available since 1963. LOHBECK's last known employment was that of manager of Okie Joe's Restaurant, 1720 Central, SE, where he worked for a brief period of time immediately followed by his disappearance from this area.

His son, KURT LOHBECK, worked for radio stations KGGM and KVOD; however, he also disappeared from the Albuquerque area at approximately the same time as his father after being involved in several controversial matters.

On 7/10/67, Mr. ROMAN FRANKIN, Okie Joe's Restaurant, Albuquerque, N.M., advised that DON LOHBECK formerly managed that restaurant and cocktail lounge for a brief period of time, but disappeared approximately four years ago.

On 7/10/67, [REDACTED] Credit Bureau of Albuquerque, Albuquerque, N.M., advised that DON LOHBECK's record was in the dead file, having had no inquiries on him since 1962. She stated that there were numerous accounts for collection in his files. She had no information as to his current whereabouts.

Regarding KURT LOHBECK, [REDACTED] advised that he was last employed in Albuquerque by KQGM Radio, according to their files. However, they have no other active local information on him. She stated an inquiry was received in 12/64, concerning KURT LOHBECK, at which time his address was 8921 Cardinal Terrace, St. Louis, Missouri, and he was employed by Swiftway Foods in St. Louis.

St. Louis will immediately locate and interview KURT LOHBECK and his father, DONALD LOHBECK, and submit results thereof in LHM suitable for dissemination in accordance with instructions set forth in enclosed Buairtel to Albuquerque dated 7/6/67. It is to be noted that files of the Dallas and Albuquerque Divisions fail to disclose that LOHBECKs had any contact with LEE HARVEY OSWALD.
