SUBJECT: Assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy Dallas, Texas, November 22, 1963

> Reference is made to the Bureau memorandum of May 15, 1967, indicating the request of Patrolman Raymond Comstock, New Orleans Police Department, for the return of certain documents concerning David William Ferrie.

We have been informally advised by the United States Attorney, Eastern District of Louisiana, that the District Attorne of New Orleans recently subpoenaed the financial records of the Whitney National Bank, New Orleans in an apparent effort to ascer tain the source of the large deposits recorded on the first page of Ferrie's bank book. We assume therefore, that there is now no need for the Department of Justice to release copies of the letters and bank book to the District Attorney.
