NEW ORLEANS STATES ITEM, FINAL EDITION, JULY TWELVE,  
INSTANT, REPORTED THAT JUDGE EDWARD A. HAGGERTY, TODAY  
THREW OUT A PETITION FILED BY ATTORNEYS FOR CLAY L. SHAW  
AIMED AT PREVENTING DA JIM GARRISON FROM APPEARING ON A  
NATIONALLY TELEVISED PROGRAM TO DISCUSS HIS KENNEDY ASSASSINATION  
PROBE. THE ARTICLE REPORTED HAGGERTY TOLD THE DEFENSE  
HE HAD ISSUED FOUR SETS OF GUIDELINES GOVERNING STATEMENTS  
MADE IN CONNECTION WITH SHAW'S CASE. HE REPEATED AGAIN TODAY  
THAT PERSONS "INCLUDING LAWYERS HAVE ACTED AT THEIR PERIL"  
IN DISCUSSING THE CASE PUBLICLY BUT SAID HE COULD NOT  
ANTICIPATE VIOLATIONS OF THE GUIDELINES. JUDGE HAGGERTY  
SAID HE FULLY INTENDS TO CITE CERTAIN PERSONS FOR CONTEMPT  
AND HE HAS ISSUED SEVERAL WARNINGS AGAINST VIOLATORS OF THE

PUBLIC STATEMENT GUIDELINE. JUDGE HAGGERTY WAS ALSO QUOTED AS SAYING THAT IF THE DEFENSE FEELS ITS RIGHT TO A FAIR TRIAL HAS BEEN JEOPARDIZED IN NEW ORLEANS IT MAY ASK FOR A CHANGE IN VENUE AND MOVE THE TRIAL TO A DIFFERENT LOCALITY.

ARTICLE REPORTED THAT JUDGE HAGGERTY WARNED GARRISON THAT HE IS LIABLE NOT ONLY TO THE JUDGE'S GUIDELINES BUT TO "THE STRINGENT RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LOUISIANA BAR ASSOCIATION AND MORE PARTICULARLY, THE COMMITTEE ON GRIEVANCES AND ETHICS".

ARTICLE REPORTED THAT GARRISON IS SCHEDULED TO MAKE A NATIONWIDE TELEVISION APPEARANCE ON NBC FROM SEVEN TO SEVEN THIRTY PM, SATURDAY, JULY FIFTEEN NEXT.

ARTICLE REPORTED THAT WILLIAM GURVICH, FORMER GARRISON AIDE, WHO WAS SCHEDULED TO TESTIFY BEFORE THE ORLEANS PARISH GRAND JURY TODAY SAID HE UNDERWENT LIE DETECTOR TESTS IN CHICAGO TO BACK UP HIS CONTENTION THAT GARRISON'S PROBE HAS NO SUBSTANCE. ACCORDING TO THE ARTICLE, GURVICH SAID THE LIE DETECTOR TESTS WERE PERFORMED BY JOHN E. REID, HEAD OF JOHN E. REID AND ASSOCIATES, AND ACCORDING TO THE ARTICLE
