TWO: THAT THE FOREMAN OF THE GRAND JURY STATE IN OPEN COURT THE CRIME ABOUT WHICH SHERIDAN IS SUBPOENAED TO TESTIFY.

THREE: THAT A HEARING BE HELD TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE GRAND JURY IS LEGALLY CONSTITUTED.

FOUR: THAT ATTORNEY MILTON BRENER BE ALLOWED TO ACCOMPANY SHERIDAN BEFORE THE GRAND JURY DURING HIS TESTIMONY SO THAT HIS LEGAL RIGHTS CAN BE EXPLAINED TO HIM AT ALL STAGES OF THE PROCEEDINGS.

FIVE: THAT A CONTRADICTORY HEARING BE HELD TO DETERMINE WHETHER GARRISON AND HIS ASSISTANTS SHOULD BE RECUSED FROM ADVISING THE GRAND JURY ON ANY MATTERS INVOLVING SHERIDAN.

THE ARTICLE REPORTED THAT CRIMINAL DISTRICT JUDGE BERNARD J. BAGERT STAYED THE SUBPOENA FOR SHERIDAN TO APPEAR BEFORE THE GRAND JURY "PENDING A DETERMINATION OF THE ISSUES" RAISED BY SHERIDAN'S ATTORNEYS. JUDGE BAGERT STATED HE EXPECTS TO HOLD A HEARING WITHIN FORTY-EIGHT HOURS AND PROMISED TO RENDER A DECISION IMMEDIATELY.
