A review of the files regarding LEE HARVEY OSWALD shows that from May or June, 1954 until approximately February, 1955 OSWALD was residing in New Orleans, La. The files further show that OSWALD joined the Marine Corps on 10/26/56 and was overseas in the Marine Corps from 9/12/57 to 12/22/58.

In view of the above information the allegations by FRANCES THRASHER do not appear to warrant any investigation.
