NEW ORLEANS STATES ITEM, RED FLASH EDITION, JULY
FOURTEEN INSTANT, REPORTED THAT WILLIAM GURVICH, ONE TIME
INVESTIGATOR FOR DISTRICT ATTORNEY JIM GARRISON, IN A PRESS
CONFERENCE PROVIDED THE RESULTS OF FIFTEEN POLYGRAPH QUES-
TIONS AND ANSWERS. STATES ITEM CONTINUES THAT JOHN LOREID
POLYGRAPH EXAMINER, CHICAGO, SAID "NO SIGNIFICANT EMOTIONAL
DISTURBANCE INDICATIVE OF DECEPTION IN THIS SUBJECT'S
(GURVICH'S) POLYGRAPH RECORD" ON THE QUESTIONS. TWO OF THE
QUESTIONS IN THE AFFIRMATIVE REPLY INVOLVED THE ALLEGED
QUESTION OF GARRISON ORDERING THE ARREST OF WALTER SHERIDAN
AND RICK TOWNLEY IN THE PRESENCE OF GURVICH. THE SECOND
QUESTION ASKED "DID GARRISON ORDER THE ARREST, HANDCUFFING
AND PHYSICAL BEATING OF SHERIDAN AND TOWNLEY?" THE REMAINING
QUESTIONS INVOLVED THE CONDUCT OF GURVICH WITH DA GARRISON'S
ATTORNEYS IN THIS MATTER.
