1. Reference is made to a report from the New Orleans office of the FBI, subject as above, dated 20 July 1967, concerning a transcript of an interview conducted by District Attorney James Garrison with a Cuban refugee, Carlos QUIROGA.

2. Certain statements made by QUIROGA may be significant. The following are illustrative:


a. P. 3. "At the same time, the only reason why I did not -- of course I was with the other group too. ... "

b. Pp. 3 - 4: QUIROGA refers to his "fight against the Warren Commission" and makes an obscure reference to trying "to infiltrate this organization".

c. P. 6. QUIA SA gave someone named Juan, not further identified, the name of one PENEQUE, who seems to have been in charge of a military training camp in Lacombe, Louisiana, in 1963. QUIROGA also gave Juan "the names of all the people I have been carrying in my ... pocket for the last four years...." **8** AUG 8 1967

d. P. 18. QUIROGA: "I'm a Cuban and I don't want to betray my country."

e. P. 23. QUIROGA says that he went to Cuba in 1960, partly on a honeymoon, partly to see his father, and partly to spend funds that he could not take out of Cuba.
