Pages S11111-S11115. Senator Hartke, (D) Indiana, placed in the Record part III of the CBS News Inquiry entitled "The Warren Report" which was broadcast in June. New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison and former FBI Agent William Turner, among others, appeared on this program. Walter Cronkite (CBS News Correspondent) in commenting on the various accounts of the assassination stated "An even more elaborate account is given by William Turner, a former F. B. I. agent, who has become a warm supporter of District Attorney Garrison." Turner's remarks are included in the text of the broadcast. (William W. Turner entered on duty as an Agent on February 5, 1951, and was discharged on July 19, 1971.)
