THE NEW ORLEANS TIMES PICAYUNE, EIGHT TWENTY NINE
SIXTYSEVEN, REPORTED THAT FEDERAL DISTRICT JUDGE, ALVIN
B. RUBIN, RULED MONDAY THAT NBC NETWORK INVESTIGATOR,
WALTER SHERIDAN, DOES NOT HAVE TO ANSWER A SUBPOENA
COMMANDING HIS APPEARANCE BEFORE THE ORLEANS PARISH
GRAND JURY. THE ARTICLE REPORTED THAT THE COURT ORDERED
A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AGAINST THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE
SUBPOENA ISSUED ON SEVEN EIGHTEEN SIXTYSEVEN AND SAID
THAT A PERMANENT INJUNCTION WILL ALSO BE GRANTED.

IN CONNECTION WITH THE QUESTION OF SHERIDAN'S APPEARANCE
BEFORE THE GRAND JURY, JUDGE RUBIN HELD THAT SHERIDAN

FROM PROSECUTING THEM ON CHARGES OF PUBLIC BRIBERY. THE
ARTICLE REPORTED THAT, WITH REGARD TO THE REQUESTED INJUNCTION
AGAINST PROSECUTION OF SHERIDAN AND TOWNLEY, THE COURT HELD
THAT ADEQUATE PROCEDURES ARE AVAILABLE IN STATE COURTS
FOR THEIR PROTECTION.
