Mr. Ambassador,

The reason of this letter is that I had several contacts with the American Consulate in Bordeaux, and I did not obtain positive results.

During the month of December 1964, I was editor with my partner in New York. We were exclusive representatives for Italy of "Encyclopedia Americana" with Headquarters in Europe at Monte Carlo "Palais de LaSalle". The Director was Burton Burn, an American citizen employed by the Grolier Intercontinental, Lexington Avenue, New York.

While in New York, I met a girl who had an explosive file on the J.F. Kennedy case. This girl was a friend of Eddie Farris, who was recently assassinated.

I wrote this in French to Mr. Garrison in New Orleans, and I have received a registered letter from Mr. R. William Martin (Assistant District Attorney, New Orleans), who urgently wants to obtain this information.

Since my French is very bad, I would prefer to release the information in Italian or in English. Inasmuch as this is forbidden by the French Authorities, I am asking you, Mr. Ambassador to find a solution to my problem.
