Enclosed to the Bureau are six copies of a letterhead memorandum dated and captioned as above. Two copies are enclosed to Dallas.

The source referred to is [redacted] who furnished the information to SAs HELEN BRITTON, III, and ALBERT B. MILLER. It is observed [redacted] during contact by these Special Agents on 8/23/67, advised of the information, and on 8/24/67, after checking his records, supplied the probable date of the planned meeting.

[redacted] to date it would appear no Federal violation exists.

[redacted] has furnished the information that he has nearly a half million dollars [redacted] and from contact with him it would appear he should be in a position to furnish information regarding organized crime and the hoodlum element. In short, he has many contacts in all walks of life and has professed a desire to cooperate with the FBI.

[redacted] has furnished pertinent information regarding organized crime in New Orleans, and is well aware of the confidential nature and significance of the information he has and will furnish. He has specifically insisted that his identity be kept confidential for fear of his life. He has been assured that his identity will be kept confidential.

In view of the foregoing, the information set forth in the letterhead memorandum has been paraphrased carefully. The details of the matter are as follows:

On 8/23/67 PCI [redacted] commented that shortly after DEAN ANDREWS publicly announced that CLAY BERTRAND was EUGENE DAVIS.
