On August 24, 1967, a confidential source, who has not been contacted with sufficient regularity to determine source's reliability, furnished the following information which source had received:

About [REDACTED] there was supposed to be a secret meeting of Ross Scaccia, described by source as a United States Attorney, Clay Shaw and Eugene Davis. The meeting was to take place in the law office of Lee Leonard, National Bank of Commerce Building, New Orleans, Louisiana. According to the information that source had received, Scaccia, before he became a U. S. Attorney, practiced law with Leonard. Source did not know the purpose of the meeting.

It is observed that Ross T. Scaccia is an Assistant U. S. Attorney, Eastern District of Louisiana, New Orleans, Louisiana.

The Greater New Orleans Telephone Directory, December, 1966, lists Lee R. Leonard as an attorney, National Bank of Commerce Building, New Orleans, Louisiana.
