"If our case is so bad, why not let us go to trial and lose it? Why must high government officials and national that Garrison has information television networks and great about the assassination "but magazines work so hard can sabotage the case before trial? The answer is that they know by now that we are not going to lose it. .

"Finding out what happened in Dealey Plaza and why it happened was not that hard. The hard part is keeping elements of the federal government and great new agencies from being successful in this potential jurors in the advance of the trial

"It is a little disconcerting to find the chief justice of the United States on his hands and knees trying to tie some sticks of dynamite to the case. However, the chief justice is a practical man and I expect he knows what he is doing.
