Ferry Raymond Russo, referred to in attached, is Jim Garrison's star witness against Clay L. Shaw. Russo testified at a preliminary hearing that Shaw was present at a time when a conspiracy was hatched to assassinate John F. Kennedy.

Russo testified after having been given a hypnotic drug and much publicity has been given to the allegation that Russo's testimony was the result of post-hypnotic suggestion. During a recent televised interview, Russo said that he actually had no recollection of Shaw.

Dean Andrews, referred to in attached, is a New Orleans attorney who was recently convicted of giving perjured testimony to a grand jury in connection with the existence of a person named Clay Bertrand, whom Jim Garrison claims is identical to Clay L. Shaw.
