On September 5, 1967, a handwritten letter dated August 28, 1967, was received at the San Antonio Office of the FBI and bore the signature of Mrs. Annie R. Patterson. It bore the return address Carcel de Mujeres, Carr. Mex., Puebla, Mexico D.F., Mexico. This letter was written to Mr. Cole, Manager, FBI, San Antonio, Texas, U.S.A.

A copy of this letter is attached hereto.

It is to be noted that the writer of this letter commented she had met Mr. Cole in Norfolk (state not mentioned). It is further to be noted that Special Agent in Charge J. Myers Cole of the San Antonio FBI Office does not recall meeting Mrs. Annie R. Patterson.
