

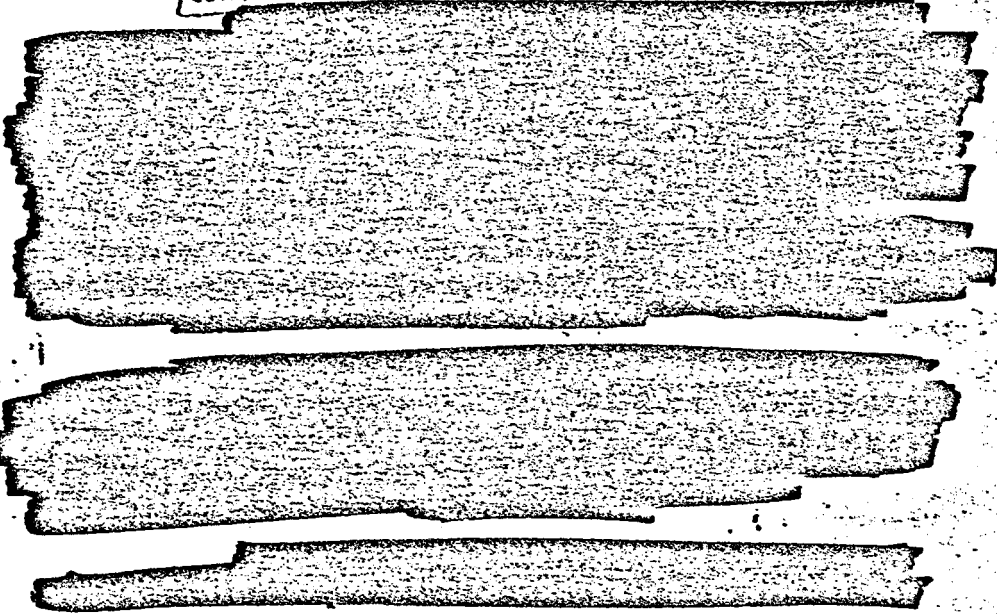

CHARLES P. ENGLISH

On August 25, 1967, captioned individual, who indicated he was residing at the Biscayne Terrace Hotel, Miami, Florida, telephonically contacted a Special Agent at FBI Headquarters, Washington, D. C. English advised that he was planning to hold a press conference at noon on that date at the Biscayne Terrace Hotel at which time he planned to discuss the assassination of President Kennedy. He declined to give any further details.
