The District Attorney's office. Wednesday denied allegations of a second supplemental motion to quash Clay 1. Shaw's conspiracy indictment in Criminal District Court.

The denial was contained in an answer signed by Assistant District Attorney James L. Alcock, Assistant District Attorney Joseph N. Marcal III filed the. answer with Judge Edward A.; Haggerty Jr.

The second supplementary motion was filed during a twoday hearing on another motion to quash. The hearing was end-ed Tuesday by Judge Haggerty, who promised to rule on both motions Monday.

The second motion said the Louisiana code of criminal pro-cedure provides that the general venire from which names of prospective grand jurors are drawn shall contain no fewer than 750 names.
