Enclosed for your consideration is a copy of a 11ft letter received from Mr. Terry Christie, of Dalton, Georgia, concerning the assassination of the late President Kennedy.

The information in the letter is not specific enough to permit us to determine whether the Professor to whom Mr. Christie refers is mentioned in the one-volume Report or the set of volumes of hearings and exhibits of the Warren Commission or has related his story to the Bureau.

Therefore, we are unable to respond to the allegations in the letter, and request that the Bureau formulate and send to Mr. Christie an appropriate reply.
