CREW AIRCRAFT-POSSIBLE HIJACKING B7-4-36 mt

For information of Memphis, subject telephonically contacted this office November 22, 1965, and advised he wanted to inform of a plot to hijack an American airplane and take it to Cuba. Subject stated he was a doctor working at Sewart Air Force Base in Nashville, Tennessee.

The following investigation was conducted by SA JAMES P. HOFFMAN and SA ROBERT F. STULAZ at New Orleans, Louisiana, on November 22, 1965:

FRANK RUFFINO, 639 St. Phillip Street advised subject has rented Apartment 2 for several months while employed at the Clarity Hospital. RUFFINO said subject left the apartment today indicating he was catching a plane.

Dr. JOHN ADRIANI, Chief Anesthetist, Clarity Hospital advised subject has been under his instructions as an anesthetist since January, 1965. He stated he has been released by the hospital as a result of suffering a relapse of mental illness which he had while in his "vacation". Dr. ADRIANI further advised that in early morning of November 22, 1965, subject came and saw him. Dr. ADRIANI realized subject was in need of medical help and immediately contacted subject's parents, Mr. and Mrs. JOHN J. MCKINOSH, Nashville, Tennessee, and advised them to come and get their son.

Mr. J. HOFFMAN, Assistant to Dr. ADRIANI advised subject's parents arrived in New Orleans this date and
