On 11/6/67, Mr. LEE REDFORD, Office Manager and Bookkeeper, Dickerson Confort Center, 12308 Hempstead Highway, Houston, Texas, advised his files contain no record of CLARENCE A. PELTON.

On the same date, Mr. BILL DICKERSON, former operator of Dickerson Confort Center, advised the name CLARENCE A. PELTON was not familiar to him.

Mrs. BESS DICKERSON, Dickerson Plumbing Company, 6838 O Street, Houston, Texas, advised on 11/6/67 that she had no personnel records of any PELTON having worked for her company and the name of PELTON was not familiar to her.

On 11/6/67, Mr. LEO C. DICKERSON, owner of the Atlantic Plumbing Supply Company, 1906 69th Street, who formerly owned and operated the Dickerson Company, Houston, Texas, advised that no one by the name of PELTON ever worked for him while he operated the Dickerson Company.

UACB, no additional investigation being conducted by Houston to identify the Dickerson Company which formerly employed CLARENCE A. PELTON in Houston, Texas. In the event additional handwriting and hand printing samples are required, Dallas should recontact PELTON to determine specifically which Dickerson Company he was employed by in 1963.

The FBI Lab upon completion of examination is requested to return to the Houston Division the handwriting specimens submitted herewith.
