News media reported 11/2/67 that Roger Craig, former Dallas County Deputy Sheriff, claimed someone shot at him 11/1/67 in Dallas. Craig told newsmen he felt an attempt was made on his life because he has been in contact with New Orleans District Attorney James C. Garrison. Dallas Office interviewed Craig 11/25/63 in connection with his claim that an individual he subsequently identified as Lee Harvey Oswald, departed the Texas School Book Depository Building immediately following the assassination in a station wagon driven by unknown man. Craig's statements were never corroborated. Investigation disclosed Oswald left the Texas School Book Depository Building by bus and later transferred to a taxicab to proceed to his rooming house.
