His letter directed to the Attorney General is to be acknowledged. Mr. Christie should be thoroughly interviewed regarding the allegation made, and the identity of the SMU Professor should be established so that he may be interviewed.

The results of your interview are to be incorporated into a letterhead memorandum suitable for dissemination, copies of which are to be furnished to Dallas and New Orleans.

Dallas upon receipt of the information from the Atlanta Division should thoroughly interview the SMU Professor regarding this matter unless information in Dallas files precludes such an interview with the SMU Professor, at which time Bureau is to be promptly advised. Results of this interview are to be incorporated into a letterhead memorandum.

This matter is to be handled immediately.
