ReBuairtel to Dallas, 11/2/67, a copy of which, together with one copy of each of the enclosures described therein, are furnished the New Orleans Office for information, inasmuch as Buairtel makes reference to the JIM GARRISON investigation in New Orleans.

Without a name of the SMU professor, no indices search to identify the former neighbor of JACK RUBY is possible; however, for the information of Bureau and Atlanta, as of 11/22/63 JACK RUBY was residing in Apartment 207, 223 South Ewing, Dallas, Texas. All residents of the apartment building were interviewed and no persons during such interviews related any facts such as those attributed to the unknown SMU professor. Furthermore, investigation into the activities of LEE HARVEY OSWALD immediately prior to and following the assassination, establishes without a doubt that LEE HARVEY OSWALD spent the night before the assassination at the residence of Mrs. RUTH PAINE in Irving, Texas.

Special Agents familiar with the details of the RUBY-OSWALD investigation recall no such allegation as attributed to the unknown SMU professor.

It would appear that the foregoing information is sufficient for appropriate acknowledgment of Mr. CHRISTIE's letter, and the Atlanta Office is not being requested to interview Mr. TERRY CHRISTIE to establish the identity of the professor currently with SMU, UACB.
