ROBERTS has been referred to the U. S. Attorney and law libraries for the answers to most of his questions.

When ROBERTS last appeared at the Dallas Office on 11/13/67, he stated he is using this information to prepare a book on the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY. He said he is a free lance writer and will attempt to sell his book when it is completed. R

ROBERTS is a very nervous individual.

The Bureau is being advised of the above in view of subject's statement that he is writing a book concerning the assassination of President KENNEDY.
