BURNS, Richard.

Accident BA for Gazzioen.

Cuban. Possible witness. Ascerding to Bean Andrews.

Busnedo was subpossed during Shaw's proliminary bearing and

Garrison will name him as one of the assessins.





CANCLER, John.

Vitness. Corrieted barglar who charged that Garrison's staff tried to belle him.

GARBALLO, Rose.

Cuban. Has been conducting his own investigation, possibly on bahalf of Garrison.

CARTER, Keeneth.

Peocible witness. Perry Ruspe has claimed that Carter was at Ferrie's apartment early in the evening when, later, the accessization plot was allegedly discussed.

CHETTA, Dr. Nichelas.

Coroner for New Origans Parish.

COFFET, Melvin.

Pessible witness. Was questioned by Garrison's effice, as were David Forsie and Aivin Bounbood, soon after the association.


COLVIN, Ernect Jr.

Cuban. Delegate of the Christian Democratic Movement in New Orleans. Collected funds for the Cuban Revolutionary Council.

DALZELL, William Wayne.

Witness. Brought to Garrison's office by a subpoena issued 3 June 1967. One of the incorporators of Friends of Democratic Cuba.

DANN, Sal.

Attorney for Jack Ruby. Has urged that Garrison be disbarred.

DAVIS, Eugene C.

Possible witness. Dean Andrews claimed Davis used the alias Clay or Clem Bertrand, said by Garrison to have been used as an alias by Shaw. Andrews was convicted of perjury.

DAVIS, Howard Kenneth.

Associated with Gerald Patrick Hemming Jr. in giving paramilitary training to Cubans.

Cuban. A GOC infiltration agent at the training camp at Lacombe, La.

Cuban. Alleged by Carlos Quiroga to have been one of a nineteen men Miami group that underwent para-military training at Lacombe, La.

Cuban, Investigator for Garrison.


HEMMING, Gerald Patrick Jr.



Possible witness. He and o Jack S. Martin were case desployed by private detective Guy Bazistar. Levis has claimed to know the names of five persons who picted the assassination.



Possible witness, although to date Garrison has not been able to extradite him from Ohio. Like Norton, Novel falsely claims affiliation with CIA.

ODIO, Sylvia (Mrs.)

Possible witness. Lives in Dallas, where, she claims, she was visited by two Cubans and Oswald.

ODOM, Lee.



SHERIDAN, Walter.


Possible witness. NBC investigator accused by Garrison of attempted bribery in connection with the case.
