Your letter of December 12th, with enclosure,
has been received.

In response to Dr. R. J. Mitchell's inquiry, you
may wish to advise him that the FBI at the request of Presi-
dent Johnson conducted a prompt, intensive, objective and
thorough investigation of the assassination of President John F.
Kennedy. All the material developed by this Bureau in
connection with this investigation was turned over to the
Warren Commission for its consideration, and the results
of our inquiry were subsequently made available to the
National Archives by the Warren Commission. The FBI
has no authority to independently release any information
in these reports.
