Enclosed for Dallas is a Xerox copy of the letter dated December 8, 1967, addressed to Senator Robert F. Kennedy. This communication is self-explanatory, and included with the letter are exhibits 1 and 1B relating to photographs which were located by the correspondent Richard E. Sprague.

This information was furnished to the Bureau from the Office of Senator Robert F. Kennedy, and the original communication has been returned to his office.

Dallas should review the enclosures to Sprague's letter in detail to determine which photographs have previously been reviewed. Following this review, Dallas should submit recommendations as to whether efforts should be made to obtain photographs not reviewed to determine whether they have any pertinent bearing relating to the assassination investigation.

Based on information furnished, Richard E. Sprague was not identified in Bureau files.
