RE NEW ORLEANS TEL TO BUREAU, DEC. THIRTEEN LAST, AND DALLAS AIRTEL TO BUREAU, DEC. FOURTEEN LAST, CONCERNING DA JAMES GARRISON'S ALLEGATIONS IN CONNECTION WITH ASSASSINATION PROBE.

DEPUTY SHERIFF BUDDY WALTHERS, DALLAS COUNTY SO, ACCORDING TO NEWS ARTICLE APPEARING IN THE DALLAS MORNING NEWS, DEC. FOURTEEN LAST, STATED GARPISON WAS WRONG IN HIS CLAIM THAT FEDERAL AGENT FOUND FORTYFIVE CALIBER BULLET AT SCENE OF ASSASSINATION. WALTHERS IS IDENTIFIED AS THE DEPUTY SHERIFF APPEARING IN THE PHOTOGRAPH NEAR THE UNIDENTIFIED ALLEGED FEDERAL AGENT. WALTHERS IS QUOTED AS STATING "I NEVER SAW ANY BULLET. THAT'S ALL THERE IS TO IT. IF HE HAD FOUND A BULLET HE WOULD HAVE SHOUTED 'LOOK, A BULLET'". THE ARTICLE DID NOT INDICATE WHETHER WALTHERS RECOGNIZED THE UNIDENTIFIED FEDERAL AGENT.
