SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT
JOHN F. KENNEDY
NOVEMBER 22, 1963,
DALLAS, TEXAS

At 10:20 a.m. on December 26, 1967, Special Agent Ernest Wall of the New Orleans Office called to advise that through a newspaper source they learned that District Attorney James Garrison was going to hold a major press conference scheduled for 11 a.m. 12/26/67 at the Monteleone Hotel. Mr. Wall advised that former Special Agent William Turner and the publisher of "Ramparts" magazine would appear at the press conference.

The Bureau was previously advised by the New York Office of the proposed press conference by District Attorney Garrison. Former Special Agent Turner has, in the past, written articles concerning the assassination which have appeared in "Ramparts" magazine.

ACTION:

None. New Orleans advised that they would furnish the Bureau with any further information coming to their attention or which would appear in news media in that area.
