ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY,
DALLAS, TEXAS, NOV. TWENTYTWO, SIXTYTHREE, MISCELLANEOUS -
INFO CONCERNING, OO: DALLAS.

WNNR NEWS AT TWELVE FORTYFIVE PM TODAY REPORTED THAT
DA JIM GARRISON HELD A PRESS CONFERENCE TODAY IN WHICH HE
SAID THAT AT LEAST FIFTEEN PERSONS WERE INVOLVED IN THE
ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY. THE NEWS CONFERENCE
WAS DESCRIBED BY THE NEWSCASTER AS A RAMBLING PRESS
CONFERENCE. ACCORDING TO THE NEWSCASTER, GARRISON WAS
CRITICAL OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FOR NOT RELEASING DOCUMENTS
WHICH HE SAID WERE ESSENTIAL TO HIS INVESTIGATION. THE
NEWSCASTER STATED THAT GARRISON EXPRESSED CONCERN THAT THESE
DOCUMENTS MAY BE CHANGED BEFORE THEY ARE RELEASED TO THE
PUBLIC.

THE NEWSCASTER REPORTED THAT GARRISON, IN CRITICIZING
THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SAID, "PRESIDENT JOHNSON KNOWS VERY
WELL THAT LEE OSWALD DID NOT UPLL THE TRIGGER".
