THE NEW ORLEANS STATES ITEM TONIGHT CARRIES HEADLINES "OSWALD TOLD FBI OF PLOT TO KILL JFK, SAYS DA".

PAPER CARRIES ARTICLE BY REPORTER ROSEMARY JAMES. THIS ARTICLE REFLECTS THAT DA JIM GARRISON SAID IN NEW ORLEANS TODAY THAT LEE HARVEY OSWALD, ACTING AS A FEDERAL INFORMANT, TOLD THE FBI FIVE DAYS BEFORE THE ASSASSINATION OF JOHN F. KENNEDY THAT AN ATTEMPT WOULD BE MADE ON THE PRESIDENT'S LIFE.

GARRISON, WHILE SPEAKING AT A PRESS CONFERENCE AT THE MONTELEONE HOTEL IN NEW ORLEANS, SAID HE HAS EVIDENCE THAT THOSE INVOLVED IN A CONSPIRACY TO KILL MR. KENNEDY HAD A FINAL MEETING, SUNDAY, NOVEMBER SEVENTEEN, SIXTYTHREE. THE ARTICLE QUOTES

GARRISON "THAT DAY, THE FBI SENT OUT A TWX (INTERBUREAU TELEGRAM) ANNOUNCING THAT ON NOV. TWENTYTWO, AN ATTEMPT WILL BE MADE TO

ASSASSINATE JOHN F. KENNEDY IN DALLAS."

THE ARTICLE REFLECTS GARRISON STATED THAT OSWALD WAS EMPLOYED AS AN FBI INFORMANT AND THAT THOSE INVOLVED IN THE CONSPIRACY KNEW OSWALD WAS AN INFORMANT AND INTENDED ALL ALONG TO "MAKE HIM THE GOAT". THE ARTICLE REFLECTS THAT THE TELEGRAM CONTAINING THE ALLEGED PLOT INFORMATION "WENT TO J. EDGAR HOOVER. WHAT CAME DOWN TO THE PRESIDENT, YOU CAN JUDGE FOR YOURSELF IN THAT HE WAS ALLOWED TO RIDE WITHOUT A BUBBLE TOP IN THAT PARADE IN DALLAS."

THE ARTICLE FURTHER REFLECTS THAT GARRISON SAID THAT EDGAR EUGENE BRADLEY OF NORTH HOLLYWOOD, CALIF., WHOM HE CHARGED LAST WEEK WITH CONSPIRING TO ASSASSINATE THE PRESIDENT, TRIED IN 1964 TO WORK UP SUPPORT IN CALIFORNIA FOR HOOVER AS A PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE. HE WAS UNSUCCESSFUL GARRISON SAID BECAUSE "THE ASSASSINATION TEAM JUST WASN'T THAT LARGE."

THE ARTICLE STATES THAT GARRISON SAID THAT WHILE HE DOES NOT BELIEVE PRESIDENT JOHNSON WAS INVOLVED IN THE ASSASSINATION, HE CONSIDERS HIM AN ACTIVE ACCESSORY AFTER THE FACT. GARRISON

CALLED THE PRESIDENT THE "MOST ACTIVE PERSON IN THE COUNTRY IN PROTECTING THE ASSASSINS OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY".

GARRISON, ACCORDING TO THE ARTICLE, STATED THAT THE PRESIDENT HAD TO KNOW THAT "OSWALD DID NOT PULL THAT TRIGGER AND HE HAD TO KNOW IT BEFORE SUNSET, NOVEMBER TWENTYTWO, SIXTYTHREE."
