New York is instructed to interview [redacted] b7c acknowledge her communication directed to the Attorney General, and determine what information she has concerning the assassination of President Kennedy.

The results of this interview are to be incorporated into a letterhead memorandum suitable for dissemination, copies of which are to be furnished to U. S. Secret Service New York and to Dallas for the completion of Dallas files.

Based on information furnished, [redacted] b7c was not identified in Bureau files. Handle expeditiously.

[REDACTED] had indicated she had evidence relating to the assassination of President Kennedy which she wanted to transmit only to an accredited person from the office of the Attorney General.
