ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY, NOV. TWENTYTWO  
NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE, DALLAS, TEXAS. MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION  
CONCERNING. OO DALLAS.

WILLIAM GURVICH, FORMER INVESTIGATOR FOR DISTRICT ATTORNEY JIM  
GARRISON, NEW ORLEANS, VOLUNTARILY FURNISHED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION  
ON A CONFIDENTIAL BASIS TO SA WILL HAYDEN GRIFFIN:

GURVICH STATED AFTER WORKING WITH GARRISON HE FOUND THAT GARRISON  
WAS MENTALLY UNSTABLE AND WAS ONLY HARASSING PEOPLE UNDER INVESTIGATION  
BY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE. GURVICH STATED HE DECIDED TO  
WORK WITH THE DEFENSE. GURVICH AND CLAY SHAW'S ATTORNEY, IRVING  
DIAMOND, WITH TWO OF DIAMOND'S ASSOCIATES WHO ARE ATTORNEYS ARRIVED  
DALLAS JAN. TWENTYEIGHT LAST. THEY HAVE BEEN CONDUCTING NUMEROUS  
INTERVIEWS AND HAVE INTERVIEWED EXTENSIVELY GEORGE SENATOR, JACK RUEY'S  
FORMER ROOMMATE. THEY ALSO WERE PHOTOGRAPHING THE ASSASSINATION AREA.

GURVICH STATED THAT HE BELIEVED THE CONSPIRACY TRIAL WOULD BEGIN IN  
MARCH AFTER A CHANGE OF VENUE. GURVICH FURTHER ADVISED THAT SHAW WOULD  
TAKE THE STAND AND ADMIT HE WAS A [REDACTED] BUT WOULD DENY ALL  
OTHER ALLEGATIONS. GURVICH STATED DIAMOND RETURNED TO NEW ORLEANS JAN.  
TWENTYNINE LAST, AND HE AND THE OTHER ATTORNEYS WOULD LEAVE DALLAS  
THIS DATE FOR NEW ORLEANS.
