In accordance with Bureau instructions, a xerox copy of the letter from Orleans Parish Assistant District Attorney ANDREW J. SCIAMERA to SA ELMER LITCHFIELD, Resident Agent at Baton Rouge, Louisiana, was hand delivered to U. S. Attorney LOUIS C. LACOUR, Eastern District of Louisiana, New Orleans, Louisiana, on 1/25/68.

Mr. LACOUR advised by letter dated 1/26/68 that any material or information relating to material contained in the files of the Department of Justice or any information or material acquired by any person while such person was an employee of the Department of Justice as a part of the performance of his official duties or because of his official status cannot be divulged without express authority of the Attorney General of the United States.

Mr. LACOUR stated that he was forwarding to the Department of Justice the above mentioned correspondence and requested that in the future when any such correspondence is received by the FBI that it be forwarded to the Department of Justice with appropriate copy to his office. Mr. LACOUR also suggested that it was advisable upon receipt of such correspondence that his office be advised immediately telephonically. He also requested that the Department of Justice and his office be furnished with copy of any answering correspondence in connection with this matter.
