For the Director's further information in this matter, the Warren Commission, by letter dated September 21, 1964, requested to be furnished a brief summary of the scope of this Bureau's investigation to determine whether Lee Harvey Oswald had some affiliation with various subversive underground activities. By letter dated September 24, 1964, we informed the Warren Commission that we had made a nation-wide check of our files, both at Headquarters and in each of our offices and had also made a canvass of all of our security informants on a nation-wide basis. We assured the Warren Commission that all information we possessed in this particular matter had been furnished to the Warren Commission.
