The airmail communication is addressed to Mr. Lyndon B. Johnson, President of the United States of America, White House, Washington, D. C.

It bears the postmark of Brooklyn, New York, dated December 21, 1967, P.M.

ASSASSINATION of

(Dear) Sir: *President John F Kennedy*

I am writing you these few lines for the following purpose: I ask and petition you to repeal the compulsory military service law for all our Puerto Rican brothers; a law which historically is not warranted. In fact, according to the Madrid agreement with the American Puppet Government, Madrid did not give up Puerto Rico so that the Puerto Ricans should be obliged to go into compulsory military service.

And you, as President of the U.S.A., are a leopard of the forest. We have come here to defend our brothers from the Yankee yoke, which keeps the people of Puerto Rico tied to the post as a result of the threats which are made by the American Congress. We wish to warn you as follows: If, beginning as of this date, you do not give an order to the

Congress, you and many more of your gang of garroters whom you have at your disposal to take advantage of defenseless nations, are going to pay for it with your life and that of all your family. The fact is that we are ready for anything and we are sure that nothing will happen to us because we have a well-prepared plan. There are many of us in this plan. We have people, money and airplanes to accomplish, if need be, our desire. We have people in many localities of the nation and they are carrying on certain investigations which will be for the purpose of bringing you to justice. Your kind of evil has to be eliminated like poison weed; and how is poison weed eliminated? By burning it.

The people we have in Dallas and (sic) Texas are a couple dozen. As of this date, we have all the data and information concerning the death of President Kennedy; in which death, you are the main culprit of the plan to kill him. Like many other people, we can give you the names of many of them: the Puppet Governor of Dallas, Mr. Connally, the policeman who died on the same day it all happened; your subordinate, the Vice-President and many of your gang of garroters. We will make this known in a few days from now because we want to show the puppet American people who (singular) and who (plural) bears the responsibility for the death of President Kennedy.

We already know all the places you and your gang of monsters frequent, not only in one locality, but in many more. We know every move you make; both in the White House and in other places, whose names I do not wish to state here, but which we have on record for when the time comes, which is in the plan. Those places will blow up like torpedoes.

Our body of conspirators is well organized. The fact is that we are not in a single place. We are in 30 places throughout the nation. In this plan, a single race is involved and we are Spaniards of pure descent, not like America, where there are no Americans, but only a rotten mixture of all kinds.

We wish to remind you that there is a deadline of 48 days on this and no more, since, if this should fail, it would be the most deplorable case the United States of America, the nation of Yankee Gringos, will ever experience. We want this as soon as possible. Without hesitation. Awaiting your decision, we remain
