Copies for information purposes are being furnished New York, Kansas City and New Haven, as these offices have or are presently conducting investigation to locate and interview BRADLEY. Copies for information are being furnished Omaha in the event that office is requested to conduct investigation in this matter in the future.

For the information of the Omaha office, BRADLEY's name has been interjected into the investigation of President KENNEDY's assassination by New Orleans's District Attorney JAMES GARRISON.

Attempts are being made to locate and interview BRADLEY in accordance with instructions from the Bureau and the Department; specifically, to account for BRADLEY's whereabouts on 11/22/63, the day of President KENNEDY's assassination. Should the Omaha

Office possess information that BRADLEY is presently residing within that field division, no attempts should be made to proceed with an interview of BRADLEY because that office does not possess the necessary background information concerning this matter.

The following is highlighted at this time and should be noted in the event BRADLEY is located and interviewed pursuant to the Bureau and Department's request:

A review of Kansas City report of SA RICHARD L. ECKBERG dated 3/31/64 entitled "UNSUB; 1968 Beach Bonanza Airplane, VIN D5584, Registration # N724SB; ITSA" reveals as follows:

LESLIE NORMAN BRADLEY [REDACTED] mentioned in Kansas City report dated 3/31/64. On 1/13/64 Mr. JACK FLOURNOY, owner, Flournoy Flying Service, Municipal Airport, Wichita, Kansas, advised that BRADLEY came to work for him in October, 1963 as an instructor, pilot and worked for about one month when BRADLEY said he had to leave to go to see an attorney by the name of DONOVAN in New York City. FLOURNOY said that BRADLEY hitched a ride by airplane to Florida following his departure from Wichita, Kansas. The exact date of BRADLEY's departure from Wichita was not known or was not mentioned by FLOURNOY.

During an interview with BRADLEY in connection with [REDACTED] BRADLEY stated he was employed as a pilot instructor for FLOURNOY Flying Service sometime in October, 1963 and remained with this job until 11/23/63, at which time he stated he went on a six-week trip throughout the U.S., hitchhiking rides in airplanes as well as automobiles.

Further, in connection with investigation conducted relative to [REDACTED] a VINCENT DE SCOISE, JR. manager, Sky Harbor Air Service, Eppley Air Field, Omaha, Nebraska, advised as follows on 1/23/64:

He said that BRADLEY applied for a job with him around 11/20/63 and at that time BRADLEY indicated to him that he had lost his pilot's license and planned on going to Washington, D.C. in order to get it renewed. No other pertinent information is known at this time concerning BRADLEY's application for employment with DE SCOISE on 11/20/63, as this period of time was not relevant to the investigation concerning [REDACTED]

Also for the benefit of the recipient offices, DE SCOISE advised that in early January, 1964 BRADLEY could be contacted in care of JEFFREY BLYTHE, London Daily Mail, 50 Rockefeller Plaza, New York, New York. It is noted that the New York office is presently attempting to contact BLYTHE concerning BRADLEY's whereabouts.

Request of the Bureau
